Stella Goldschlag is tried in court. Indicted for crimes against humanity, the Jewish woman, who had been working as a 'grippler' for the Gestapo during World War 2, must now answer for her former cruelties. Piece by piece, the beautiful blonde's life story is unfolding, until the day of the trial. Based on real events, this theatre evening addresses big topics such as law and justice, religion and politics, loyalty and selfishness. It is the portrait of a fascinating but repulsive woman, who will stop at nothing to save her own life.

Exciting melodies, which at times remind you of the Comedian Harmonists or Josephine Baker, Polka, Chansons, Jazz: the ease of the music provides a seemingly strong contrast, but at the same time complements the brutality of the story in a fascinating way.

The world premiere of this musical comedy by Wolfgang Böhmer and Peter Lund - which has won the 'Deutsche Musical Theaterpreis' in five categories- took place 2016 at the 'Neuköllner Oper' in Berlin.
